

# HARROW GO GREEN 2021

## COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 1. The Promoter

The promoters are: Harrow Council and Harrow Biodiversity and Environment of Harrow Civic Centre, Harrow.

### 2. The competition

2.1 The title of the competition is Harrow Go Green 2021.

2.2 The competition is online entry only. Details of the competition categories and the entry process can be obtained from the competition website <https://www.harrowgogreen.com/>

### 3. How to enter

3.1 The competition will run from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021 (the "**Opening Date**") to Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 (the "**Closing Date**") inclusive. It is envisaged that winners will be notified on a date no later than 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021 (the "**Announcement Date**").

3.2 All competition entries must be received by the Promoter via online application by no later than midnight on the Closing Date. All competition entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified. To enter the competition submit a completed entry form and supporting documents via the online application portal linked on the competition website by the Closing Date.

3.3 No purchase necessary and there is no need to register for use of the website.

3.4 The Promoter will **not** accept responsibility for competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.

3.5 By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

3.8 The competition entries will be judged by a panel of judges. The decision of the panel of judges (acting reasonably) will be final.

3.9 The Promoter will send the full names of the judges to anyone who emails within one month after the Closing Date of the competition requesting details of the judges.

#### **4. Eligibility**

4.1 The competition is only open to all residents in the UK aged 6 years or over, except persons or their immediate families or households who are professionally connected with the competition or its administration; including judges.

4.2 In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the competition.

4.3 The Promoter will not accept competition entries that are:

- (a) automatically generated by computer;
- (b) completed by third parties or in bulk;
- (c) illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with; or
- (d) incomplete.

4.4 Multiple entries per individual, household or organisation are permitted but each project should be entered into only one category.

4.5 The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.

4.6 Where entries comprise projects at physical sites (eg wildlife gardens), the Promoter reserves the right to arrange a site visit with the applicant at a reasonable time and on reasonable notice for the judging panel to view shortlisted entries, and as part of the evaluation process. If judges are refused entry or otherwise unable to view the project site the Promoter may decide, in its absolute discretion, to discount that entry from further consideration.

4.7 Competition entries cannot be returned.

#### **5. The prize**

5.1 The prizes are listed on the website.

5.2 Non-cash prizes are subject to availability.

5.3 The prizes are not negotiable or transferable.

5.4 All winners will be contacted and delivery of prizes arranged directly.

## **6. Winners**

- 6.1 The decision of the judges nominated by the Promoter is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 6.2 The Promoter will contact the winner personally as soon as practicable after the Announcement Date, using the telephone number or email address provided with the competition entry.
- 6.3 The Promoter must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the Promoter will publish the surname of major prize winners and, if applicable, their winning entries or extracts thereof online within one month after the Closing Date of the competition.
- 6.4 If you object to any or all of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available, please contact the Promoter. In such circumstances, the Promoter must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

## **7. Claiming the prize**

- 7.1 Please allow 28 days for delivery of the prize, which in the case of monetary prizes will be by cheque or direct transfer to an account nominated by the winner in writing.
- 7.2 The prize may not be claimed by a third party on your behalf.
- 7.3 The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed their prize within 60 of days of the Announcement Date, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date.
- 7.4 The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.

## **8. Limitation of liability**

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

## **9. Ownership of competition entries and intellectual property rights**

- 9.1 The Promoter does not claim any rights of ownership in your competition entry, subject to condition 9.2.

9.2 You agree that the Promoter may, but is not required to, make your entry available on the competition website [www.harrowgogreen.com](http://www.harrowgogreen.com) and any other media, whether now known or invented in the future, and in connection with any publicity of the competition. 11.3 These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
